It is Perry Ellis International's position that we will not produce, or make available for sale, any product that does not fully comply with applicable federal and state regulations.

Components of our products are tested for relevant restricted substances and components or products found to have chemicals or elements that exceed state or federal limits are not used in production.

All employees of Perry Ellis International are committed to identifying and avoiding product safety hazards and our suppliers and vendors are partners in our product safety program.

CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY ACT (CPSIA)

Perry Ellis International confirms compliance with the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act of 2008 prior to each factory shipment. CPSIA Certificate of Compliance (COC) Reports for all product can be obtained by retailers and consumers at <http://inquiry.pery.com>. Each product's COC includes manufacturing date, place of manufacture, relevant regulatory test results and test lab details. CALIFORNIA PROPOSITION 65 (CA PROP 65)

Components of our products are tested for relevant restricted substances contained on the CA Prop 65 list. Components or products found to have chemicals or elements on the list are not used in production.

If components contain chemicals or elements that are on the list but required as an integral part of the product, an appropriate warning sticker is placed on product prior to shipment. Retailers are notified and advised of the appropriate warning for internet sales. Methods of transmission and content of warnings are compliant with August 2018 regulations.
